



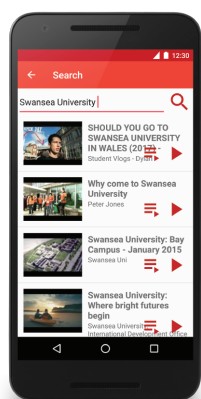

PLUGIN GUIDE

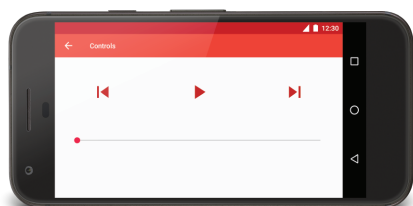


This plugin disaggregates the components of a video streaming service, allowing separate devices to each represent a single component of the interaction. In this case, one can display search queries and results, another the screen, and one the controller. Additional devices can then be added, as in the picture opposite, to view related videos or comments.

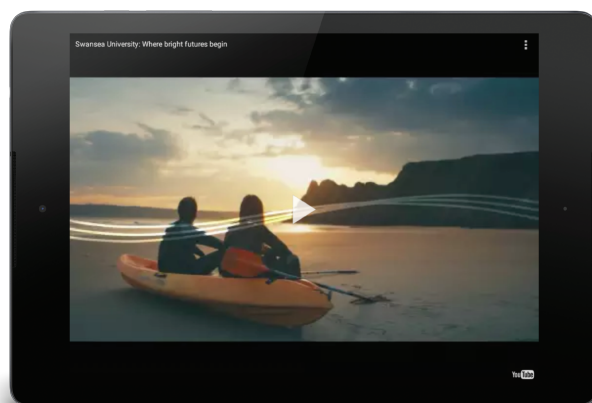
This functionality allows users to utilise the best parts of each device. For instance, if one device in the group is a tablet, this could be used as the screen, whereas if another had more airtime or higher quality speakers it could be used to provide these functions to the group.



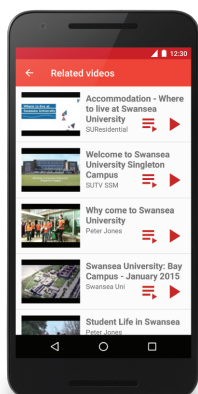
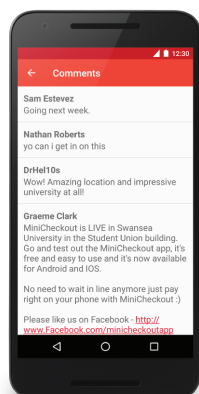
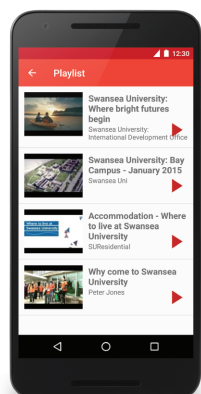
Type a search term to find a list of videos



One device can be a dedicated controller, able to play, pause, stop, fast-forward, rewind or seek.



Use the device with the biggest screen or best speakers to be the display. This is also the master device, and therefore the only one which requires an internet connection.



Other devices can display the playlist, comments or related videos, but do not require an internet connection to browse.
